INTRODUCTION

It is said that teaching creates all other professions. It is the pillar of a society. What does that make teacher Education? Probably the foundation of a Society. The process of strengthening this foundation began with another new academic term on 17 August 2013 and the B.Ed. Course for Batch of student teachers was set rolling on 05 September 2013 with an orientation. This was followed by a rigorous content enrichment programme where students analyzed content in both their methods making extensive use of concept maps.

The academic year 2013-14 was observed as the year of sustainable development Lot of activities was taken up in this area. Assemblies were conducted, various competitions organized, practices followed by the college were largely eco-friendly, community work was also done in this area.

The other highlights of the year were given below.

CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

PRACTICE TEACHING

Forming the core of teacher Education Practice teaching was divided equally between the two sessions. It started on 18 November 2013.

Several in house workshops on Micro Teaching Lesson Planning, Evaluation etc. were organized. Demonstration lesson too were a part of these workshops. Students were oriented for constructing time table and also in the use of teaching aids. To provide enriched experiences students were sent to schools affiliated to board of state.

Simulated lessons were conducted. Use of Teaching Aids and gaming Block Teaching was organized from 19 January to 24 January 2014 in many schools.

THEORY LECTURES AND EVALUATIONS: - Lectures were delivered using innovative methods and techniques like games, programme learning, supervised study methods and panel discussions. Formative as well as summative evaluation was carried out throughout the year in various forms like class test. Prompt qualitative feedback was given from time to time and the results were used to organize remedial program for the academically weak students. Students took the mandatory content test in both their methods to test their subject knowledge.

ACTION RESEARCH BASED PROJECT: - A teacher is a reflective practitioner. The continuous cycle of action reflection is an integral part of a teacher's life. In tune with this philosophy, students took up Action research based projects. These were carried out on various topics ranging from issues faced by the student teachers during their practice lessons to evaluating the B.Ed. Course.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Throughout the year students carried out their responsibilities very efficiently and celebrating important occasions like Gandhi Jayanti, Navratri, Diwali etc. It is also organized various competitions like Mehendi, Rangoli, Cooking, Thali Decoration, singing, Dance and many others events.

These Co-curricular activities provided the much needed relief from the rigors of the course. Several students participated and bagged prizes in inter collegiate competitions.

COMMUNITY WORK -

Students rendered their services to various centers as part of their community work programme.

EXTENSION WORK-

An in house extension programme was organized where students took up theme which was food festivals. The entire class was divided in to four groups and each group was assigned a student manager.

SPORT DAY

Annual sports were organized in the free and open space of college on 03 to 05 March 2014 A number of track and filed and well as team events were planned for the day. The day kick started with prayers and oath taking ceremony students were divided in four houses - Red, Green, Yellow and blue. Students enjoyed the day show casing true sportsman spirit. Sports prizes were given away on the annual prize distribution day 07/03/2014 and 08 /03/2014 adjusted the best sports person (Sumanand Ishwer Singh respectively and Green house bagged a rolling trophy for the house with highest score.

TUTORIALS AND REMEDIAL PROGRAMME. Tutorial sessions were conducted throughout the year remedial programme was also spread out the academically weak students were identified by the staff on the basis of formative evaluation which is an integral part of the curriculum. These students were given practice tests and feedback was provided to help them over come their difficulties.

ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

At the time of new admissions nears the college office is inundated with anxious calls. Since most prospective students are clueless about the admission process. The office does try to answer the queries. There was also session on the online form filling process.

LIBRARY

At the beginning of the academic year, a library orientation programme was carried out by the librarian for the new batch of students. They were oriented in a small group to the use of library collection and library catalogue. They were also informed about library services, facilities rules and regulations of the library.

Throughout the year books of different subjects were displayed. During the year 234 books have been added to the library collection, taking the total collection 6000 along with this college library also subscribed to 15 journals and 5 magazines of different subject areas. In the academic year 2013-14, college library provided book bank scheme for Six core papers, which the students could returning with them throughout the year.
